RaceDay Scoring

Wish List



- Race Progress by segment - visual indication would be cool.
- Data screen for mobile during race that shows how many are left/how many finished
- Make RDS cloud-based
- Make and standalone apps Mac AND PC based
- Grid with key values
- Easier way to have multiple reports open simultaneously - like to look at report and participant record at same time
- Ability to perform multiple actions in same data action (like changing event and adding note)
- Option of setting up pace per 100 yard or 100 meter like in RD



RaceDay Scoring

Wish List Continued



- Biggest hesitation to switch is not being able to backup race on flash drive & not having a master list auto-populate entries for previous participants. Want backup solutions with NO INTERNET.
- Want middleware (ChronoTrack Fusion Direct Stream) disconnection notices pop up prominently on dashboard and persist until dismissed for prompter troubleshooting.
- In the event of dropping a direct stream because of a middleware disconnection, would be great if there's a way to have software check that no reads came in disconnection and bring them in.
- Want to customize the dashboard, maybe even on a race-by-race basis
- Being able to select the "pass" number through a timing point/split, especially for splits that do not read the initial time through the timing point.
- Issues with slower internet connections - way for RDS to test connection and show visual "warning" that there may be issues with uploading



RaceDay CheckIn App

Wish List



- Easier group bib assignment
- More editable fields in website CheckIn mode
- Alert when volunteer mistypes a bib number that is severely out of sequence (I.E., this is not within 3 digits of recently assigned bibs)
- Being able to see event & participant information on camera bib assignment screen (when "auto-show camera on bib assignment" option is enabled) when checking in related transactions and selecting "Check-in All" - camera screen just has ble bar that says "Checking in Y of X" and "Same Transaction".
- More choices for label printing - basically anything on RunSignup as a configurable option (I.E. Corral Start Times)
- Sending support tickets from inside App (also from Mobile timing app)



RaceDay CheckIn App

Wish List Continues



- RaceDay CheckIn Report - show hourly (for staffing needs)
 - RaceDay Tools >> RaceDay Checkin >>CheckIn Stats
 - Download with specific times
 - Quick view of check-in by time
- Prevent unknown runners check-in
 - I.E., apply to only one event for on-site registration without a password
- On Check-In All for a team, show some details for each team member checked in (like bib, shirt)
- Windows CheckIn App: Ability to look up by team name
- When renewing race in CheckIn App, ask which configuration you want for it and remember presets
- More data on registrants in the CheckIn App
 - a. Store purchases, qualification for series medal



RaceDay Results

Timer Wish List



- Sorting results without having to separate/sort after the race, before inputting
- Live clock feature on results page
- Change results page colors
- Publish results - more than one event to be timed
- Different customizations & participant data cards for results pages
- More results customization for people not using RDS
- Better RSU Division Result Management



RaceJoy

Wish List



- RaceDay Scoring Integration with RaceJoy for timing data / split transmission
- Bring RaceJoy into RaceDay Scoring
 - Map View?
 - GPS Data?
- Customization of Event Shell
 - White Labeling

Wish List

- Data screen for mobile during race that shows how many are left and how many finished.
- Review the items from yesterday's planning
 - Photo Integration
 - Announcer Streaming to Mobile
 - Video Streaming
