





Answering Questions

With AI

 Participants are looking for fast, easy ways to get answers to questions like "how do I transfer events"

- Al can answer questions for you, but only if the correct answer is available to Al
 - The more answers
 available, the less
 hallucination is likely.
- Integrate an AI chatbot for customer service with insight and control





Buying With AI?

- Today, ChatGPT offers links to registration sites when asked about upcoming events
- Recently announced Agentic Commerce Protocol (ACP) for ChatGPT + Agent Payment Protocol (AP2) for Google to allow for registration within Al sessions
 - Buy it capability currently focused on products (Etsy), but expected to expand to things like tickets, and eventually registrations.

The great thing about the internet is that it's always changing. So start now - you can always make updates and improvements later!

You don't have to know everything to start somewhere!

How Your RaceGets Found

GEO (generative engine optimization)

- Same idea as SEO (search engine optimization), but specifically with AI in mind
- Ensuring your events are found (and the information is accurate)
- Al is a small piece of search today, but it will increase quickly; likely becoming the 3rd marketplace by the end of the year

Easier Implementation of AI Tools

 The RunSignup AI Chatbot will depend on the content you add to work





Writing for GEO Prioritize User Intent

Old: focus on keyword optimization New: user intent - focused on the *goal* of the searcher

- More conversational language
 - Mimic speech (not formal writing)
- It's not how many times you use "Philadelphia 5K", it's how clearly you answer the question "What's the best 5K in Philadelphia?"

Old: focus on keyword optimization

- Readability is key
- Direct answers with actionable advice
 - Use lists
- Answer multiple questions!

- · A two hour concert from local bands






Writing for GEO Prioritize User Intent

Old: focus on keyword optimization New: user intent - focused on the *goal* of the searcher

- Long-tail keywords
 - Answering the exact question, not the overarching topic
- The average Google Search is 2-3 words. The average AI search is 10 words
 - More complete thoughts/questions



Writing for GEO Emphasis on Content Quality

- De-emphasize backlinks
- Prioritize expertise, experience, authoritativeness, trustworthiness
 - Use citations, reputable sources, data, and quotes
 - Quote newspaper articles about your race
 - Share data about your economic and health impact
 - Link to local running resources
 - Avoid contradictory information on your website (I.E., different price increase dates)
 - Update regularly






Writing for GEO Structure Your Content

Place the most important content high!

 Break up content into digestible chunks that map to your most common questions

 Keep pages or sections focused on intent categories (I.E. training tips, register, logistics)

- Use descriptive headings and subheadings
 - Header A, Header B, Header C
 - Not just sizes!
- First 1-2 sentences should answer the question,
 with any more detailed explanation to follow
- Incorporate lists & tables




Good for AI AND Humans!



Best Practices

ImplementingMultimedia Content

- Use video content
 - Even if it isn't played directly on the page, hosting on YouTube and linking from there to your page increases the likelihood of some content being found
 - YouTube is cited by AI increasingly frequently
- PDFs can (sometimes) be read
 - More readable for AI than traditional search, but not perfect (yet)
- Use ALT Text where images include information




Best Practices

RunSignup Websites And Crawlability

- Fast page load times
- Mobile responsiveness
 - Heavily weighted
- Clean, logical URL structure
- Event Wizard and default website template ensures your key race details are available

Why You NeedAn FAQ

For an FAQ, Content Really Is King

An FAQ ensures that **AI and humans** can quickly and easily answer questions without needing you!

RunSignup AI Chatbot

- Will require an FAQ to ensure adequate data to work with
- Will require using Websites V2

Chatbot Beta available to *all* races soon. FAQ component available NOW and is valuable even without Chatbot!




Building an FAQ

Setting Up Your FAQ

Race >> Website V2 >> Website Builder

- Add a New Component and Choose FAQ
- Select from suggested FAQ's
 - These are questions
 we know are common
- Add custom FAQ's that apply to your race



FAQBest Practices

For Human Readability

- Use a one-column section
- Add Headers to make answers easier to find
 - IE: Packet Pickup, Course Information, Race Day Logistics
 - To do this, use a Text Component (for the header), and then an FAQ component, then repeat.

For Both Humans & Al

- Use at least 5 FAQs
 - More is better
- Review your emails from last year to identify
- Monitor your questions & responses on your dashboard to adjust and improve your FAQ over time.






Track Al MentionsOf Your Race

AI Search Impact Analysis

- Free tool!
- Plug-in for Google Chrome (turn off when you don't need it)
- Evaluates search queries individually or in bulk to see where you show up in Al summaries
 - See who is showing when you are not




